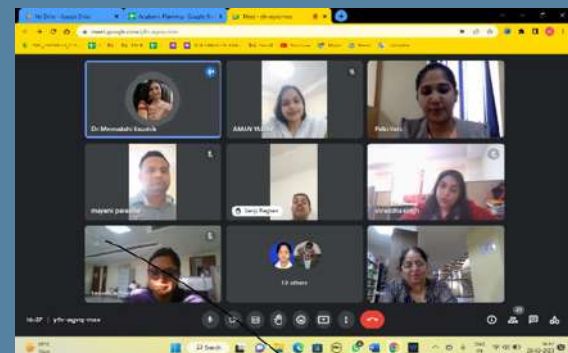

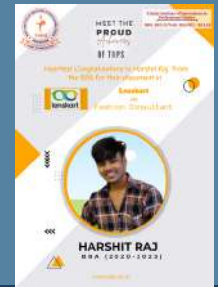

MEERA BAI: A SILENT REVOLUTIONARY DIVINE SOUL

Meera bai, a 16th century, Indian princess belonging from a Rajputana royal family (1498 – 1547) who lived in the north Indian state of Rajasthan. She was a devout follower of Shri Krishna and one of the foremost exponents of the Prem-bhakti and an inspired poetess. She was also a spiritual aspirant of love through her consistent deep and immense love, emotions, devotions and dedication and attained perfection her Krishna Bhakti.

We can analyze the charismatic and silent divine saintly personality of Saint Meera Bai and learn few lessons from her life in true essence such as dedication, devotion and commitment, eternal love and maintaining inner peace and consistent effort by seeking and realizing the truth of life of getting an enlightenment through divinity in a magnitude of human struggle within the social environment and in a period of social –religious and cultural conflicts. As a saint and poetess in medieval period she was the first woman to reflect upon the humanity, nature and God in creative unity. As a divine and peaceful soul she was the first to locate diversity and disharmony between the men and the nature .She felt empathetic and expressed her sorrow for human laws ,customs ,traditions and human’s violations since her childhood till her last breath.Inspite of belonging to Rajputana royal family and getting married to Raja Bhojraj and remaining in a magnitude of human struggle within the social environment.

Meera Bai is considered to be the first woman saint of Bhakti movement in the history of Indian religion. . Though she belonged to Rajputana royal family and got married to Raja Bhojraj,her bhakti was above all caste ,creed ,gender , inequality.Meerabai in-spite of all the conspiracies from mother-in-law and sister-in-law Uda bai and relatives of Rana & persecutions in various ways and accusations never uttered a single word of outbursts ,so Meera bai was a real silent revolutionary. She at a very early stage realized true purpose and meaning of her life. She realized that the relation with God is the only element that is true and eternal all other relationships are unreal and temporary. She followed the path of self-enlightenment to attain divinity through inner peace, devotion, dedication and attained oneness with Lord Krishna. She tried to express her heartfelt love for Krishna and spontaneous outbursts of pain of her heart and soul through her religious songs, dance and bhakti.

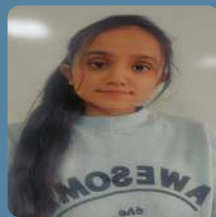
